SUPPORTING LOCAL PEOPLE WITH CEREBRAL PALSY

83 Grand Avenue Re-opens

On Friday 29th February the former Mayor of Worthing, Councillor Doctor Heather Mercer, re-opened 83 Grand Avenue, a home for 6 adults with Cerebral Palsy or like disabilities. The home is run under a Supported Living Scheme.

The interior of the property has undergone a complete refurbishment and reconfiguration to provide a one bedroom flat with a separate living room and 4 rooms for individuals all with en-suite facilities.

Most of the people present at the opening had not seen the interior of the property since the commencement of the refurbishment – all were delighted at the result. The rooms are now larger than before and the en-suite facilities well proportioned. The communal areas have been restyled and provide facilities designed to enhance independent living. Pauline Fox, the General Manager of Worthing Scope, is to be congratulated on her interior design skills. The additional funds needed for this project were raised through the 'Doorways Appeal' by more fund raising events being undertaken by staff and volunteers and through excellent trading results at our two shops.

The work cost £300,000 and was managed for Worthing Scope by Thomas & Cavalli and the building works carried out by UK Property Services (Southern) Ltd.

The project was brought in on budget and the work was completed 3 weeks ahead of schedule - a great achievement.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all donors and everyone who was involved in whatever way in enabling this refurbishment to be realised.
